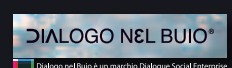

### Visit instructions of the Submarine

- The visit to the Submarine is included in the visit to the Galata Museo del Mare. No tickets are available for the Submarine only visit;
- Inside the Museum, you can visit a model of a Submarine, of the same width and height of the N. Sauro, including the shape of a narrow hatch, which anticipates what you will see on board of the Sauro (pre-show);
- you will be able to purchase the ticket Galata + Submarine (or just Galata, including the pre-show) directly at the Museum or via Internet; the tickets NavigAcquario and AcquarioVillage, which include the visit to the Galata and to the Submarine, can be purchased both at the Museum's and the Acquario's ticket counters;
- the reservation is not needed for individual visitors. If you hold an Acquario Village or NavigAcquario ticket, you will enjoy priority in case of waiting time of more than 10 minutes. Groups and schools will have to book in advance, with an allocated time, by contacting Incoming Liguria, tel. +39 010 2345666 (groups and schools of every grade), or at the Museo Galata Museum (schools of any level);
- for the individual visitors, the tour of the Submarine does not need a guide. Groups and high school visits have to be booked with Incoming Liguria. The visit of the Submarine by primary and secondary school classes requires one or more guides, in agreement with the Museum Board of Education. The visit by primary and secondary schools is only possible if the classes purchase either a theme tour or a workshop, for which booking is compulsory either with Incoming Liguria or the Museum's Board of Education;
- children under the age of 4, disabled people and the visually impaired are not allowed on the Submarine. The visit is not recommended for those who have walking difficulties, for those who suffer from claustrophobia and for those wearing thin heeled shoes. For people with special needs, specific visits can be arranged in advance;
- before getting onboard, you will have to hand in to reception the signed discharge and leave handbags and other hand held objects in the appropriate locker;
- upon delivery of an ID, you will be provided with a cap and an audio guide for free, to be worn during the visit and to be handed back at the end. The audio guide will be automatically activated at the entrance and in different points of the Submarine. In case of groups or schools, the tour leader will take on the responsibility of the audio guides given to the members;
- you will enter the Submarine by using the stern door and a staircase, whereas you will exit by the forward ones. The average length of the visit is of about twenty / twenty five minutes;
- the audio guides will provide you with further instructions, to be followed accurately. The Submarine is part of a living and working environment, to be approached with respect and attention.

A sensory path, a "journey" in total absence of light, accompanied by a blind guide, will turn familiar places and gestures into an extraordinary experience.

## USEFUL INFORMATION FOR YOUR VISIT

- **Entrance:** here you will find the ticket counter, the cloakroom, the bookshop and the groups welcome point.
- **Auditorium:** with a **100-seat capacity**, the Auditorium can host meetings, presentations, conferences and small conventions.
- **Warehouse:** this is an “operational” space of about **200 sqm** where parts of the collections never displayed before can be visited, upon reservation and accompanied by the Mu.MA. scientific staff.
- **Saletta dell'Arte:** a space dedicated to exhibitions and events dedicated to the Sea.
- **Galleria delle Esposizioni:** this is a space dedicated to exhibitions and events dedicated to the Sea.
- **Educational Space:** this is a **child dedicated area**, designed to welcome schools and provide activities tailored for them.
- **Documentation centre Renzo Piano:** here visitors can look at drawings and drafts of the Genoa waterfront future projects - **donated to the Museum by Renzo Piano**.
- **Vespucci Lounge:** dedicated to **social gatherings, banquets, weddings etc.**
- **Ramps and lift to get to the Mirador terrace.**

## GALATA FOR EVERYBODY

### For groups and schools

Various workshops, in-depth explanations and guided visits are available, suitable for all ages.

**The history of Genoa's harbour and its modern developments, the vessels that marked the history of the Genoese Republic, the “cercarelliti” (wrecks finders), oceanic voyages, scientific instruments, the submarine, migrations, etc.**

The Museum offers a variety of activities, including combined tickets with **La città dei bambini e dei ragazzi**, **l'Acquario di Genova**, **Palazzo del Principe** and **Via del Campo 29 rosso**.

### Activities available all year round upon reservation:

- **Try a sailing ship:** Visit the Galata Museo del Mare and go to sea on an ocean-going vessel.
- **Two daily appointments: 10am and 3pm.**
- **A special birthday at Galata:** with fun workshop activities:  
**On Saturdays and Sundays from 3pm to 5 pm.**

The Museum also provides special projects, addressed to schools of all levels.

### Thursdays for the Genoese:

Every Thursday. **Special ticket for Galata Museo del Mare** (Museum only, Submarine not included): € 8.00 for the single adult ticket and € 4.00 for children up to 12 years of age, only for those resident in Genoa.  
4.00 pm: **FREE AUDIOGUIDE for the Museum visit**, for those resident in Genoa only (max 30).

- **Magnetic induction amplification devices** for the hearing impaired\*
- **Tactile Map MIRAgénova**
- **Electric scooter or wheelchair** for people with walking difficulties

\* The Galata Museo del Mare is the first museum in Italy which adopted amplification devices, in order to improve the hearing along the path and inside the submarine Nazario Sauro, for hypo hearing people and all visitors with hearing problems.
